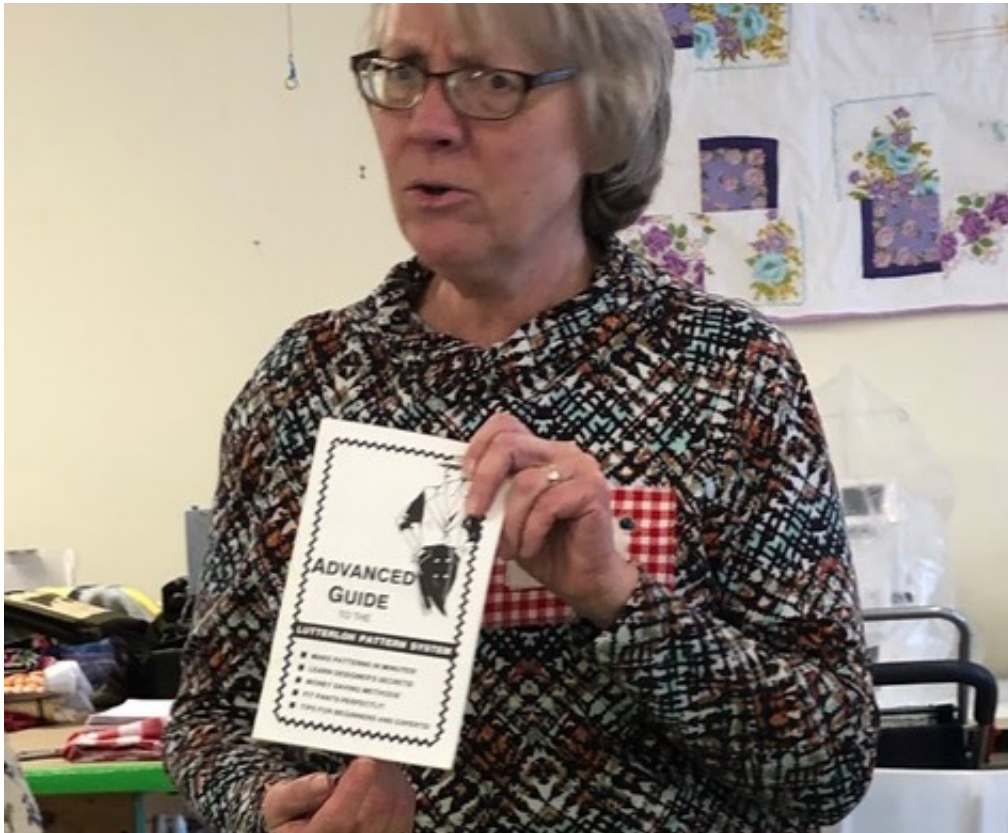
Threads (and other magazine) Offer
